in the final years of the weimar republic benjamin emerged as the most original public intellectual in the german speaking world here benjamin is represented by two of his greatest literary essays surrealism and on the image of proust as well as by an article on goethe and a selection of his wide ranging commentary for german newspapers

while kierkegaard is primarily known as a philosopher or religious thinker his writings have also been used extensively by literary writers critics and artists worldwide who have been attracted to his creative mixing of genres his complex use of pseudonyms his rhetoric and literary style and his rich images parables and allegories the goal of the present volume is to document this influence in different language groups and traditions tome i explores kierkegaard s influence on literature and art in the germanophone world he was an important source of inspiration for german writers such as theodor fontane thomas mann rainer maria rilke alfred andersch and martin walser kierkegaard s influence was particularly strong in austria during the generation of modernist authors such as rudolf kassner karl kraus robert musil and hermann broch due presumably in part to the german translations of kierkegaard in the austrian cultural journal der brenner kierkegaard continued to be used by later figures such as the novelist and playwright thomas bernhard his thought was also appropriated in switzerland through the works of max frisch and friedrich durrenmatt the famous czech author franz kafka identified personally with kierkegaard s love story with regine olsen and made use of his reflections on this and other topics

walter benjamin s antifascist education is the first comprehensive analysis of educational themes across the entirety of the critical theorist s diverse writings starting with benjamin s early reflections on teaching and learning tyson e lewis argues that the aesthetic and cultural forms to which benjamin so often turned namely radio broadcasts children s theatrical productions collections cityscapes public cinemas and word games swell with educational potentialities what emerges from lewis s reading is a constellational curriculum composed of minor practices such as poor teaching absentminded learning and nondurational studying this curriculum carries political significance offering an antidote to past and present forms of fascist manipulation hardness and coldness walter benjamin s antifascist education is a testimony to benjamin s belief that everyone is an educator and everyone needs to be educated and everything is education

walter benjamin and theodor w adorno are considered today to be the two most significant early theorists in founding critical theory in their works and correspondence both thinkers turn to art and the aesthetic as a vital way for understanding modern society and developing philosophical methods this volume of original essays seeks to understand how they influenced each other and disagreed with each other on fundamental questions about art and the aesthetic the book deals with a variety of key philosophical questions such as how does art involve distinctive modes of experience what is the political significance of modern art what does aesthetic experience teach us about the limitations of conceptual thought how is aesthetic experience implicated in the very medium of thought language ultimately the book presents a systematic argument for the foundational significance of the aesthetic in the development of the early critical theory movement

to this day there persists a widespread assumption that adorno s references to marx and especially to marx s critique of political economy represent a relic from an early and short lived stage of adorno s theoretical development on the basis of relevant and largely

unpublished textual sources this book refutes this thesis while showing that the centre of adorno s critical theory of society is occupied by a critique not only of political economy but of economy in general
